

CALL FOR CANDIDATES FOR THE CHIEF RETURNING OFFICER POSITION

The SGA/AGÉ is seeking candidates for the position of CRO for the upcoming Fall 2018 Board of Directors elections. The role of the CRO is imperative to the elections process as they oversee the election protocols, ensure proper procedures are being followed, and that the election process is fair and equitable to all involved. The CRO will begin their role on the day of the call for candidates, September 11th, 2018, and continue until the October 3rd, 2018. There are no set hours of work for the position, however the individual must hold office hours in the SGA/AGÉ office throughout the campaign period for candidate interaction and oversight. In addition, the CRO position requires weekend and evening hours at times in order to run candidate training sessions and meetings. The CRO is also required to maintain frequent email communications with those in the election process. The CRO will be the non-voting chair of and be overseen by the Election Committee.

The position is paid by a \$400 stipend at the end of the elections period once their role is completed. This position can only be filled by an SGA/AGÉ student. Interested students should be aware that the CRO cannot be affiliated with any candidates or campaign in any way at any time. They must maintain a neutral presence throughout the election process. All training is provided by the SGA/AGÉ.

Interested students are asked to please submit a copy of their resume and a cover letter to VPPolicy@laurentian.ca before **12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 7th, 2018**. All eligible candidates will be asked to attend the September 10th, 2018 Board Meeting to briefly motivate themselves for the position. If the September 10th, 2018 Board Meeting does not meet quorum, candidates will be asked to motivate themselves to the Election Committee.
