Call For Nominations:

The Students' General Association invites returning students who are interested in running for senator to fill out a nomination form at <https://sgaage.typeform.com/to/u7T6aY> by 12:00 pm, January 28th, 2019. Candidates must also be present at the SGA/AGÉ Board Meeting at 7:00 pm on January 30th, 2019 for ratification. Once ratified, successful candidates will be chosen by student vote in the February General Election of the Students' General Association.

Association Information:

The SGA/AGÉ is the largest bilingual undergraduate association at Laurentian University. The SGA/AGÉ is a nonprofit organization that exists to serve the students. There are approximately 5000 SGA/AGÉ student members at Laurentian University. We provide comprehensive representation, services, social and cultural enhancements to the student body. We create opportunities, encourage communication and participation, support growth and we make the time spent as a student more enjoyable. In addition to the Health Plan and U-Pass, SGA/AGÉ fees help fund over 50 clubs, the student Food Bank, CKLU 96.7fm Radio, The Lambda newspaper, the Voyageur Café and Student Center, the Pub Downunder, as well as numerous bursaries and grants.

Position Description:

The Senators shall represent the members of the SGA/AGÉ at the Laurentian University Senate. They shall attend and participate in meetings of the Senate and other obligations as required. Senators are responsible for communicating any decisions from Senate that may affect the membership. The Senators are members of the SGA/AGÉ's Board of Directors, and will be expected to attend and participate in all Board meetings.

Position Requirements/Qualifications:

The ideal candidate for this position possesses an excellent knowledge of Laurentian University and the SGA/AGÉ. They have a dedication to enhancing the student academic experience at the University. They will inquire into any matter that might benefit Laurentian and enhance its position in the community. This position is only open to current SGA/AGÉ students returning for the 2019/20 academic year. There will be four Senator positions available in the General Election. Candidates may not be nominated for more than one elected position.

At the time of their induction every Executive member shall be:

- At least eighteen years of age;

- Not disqualified from holding their position under this or any other Bylaw;
- Legally eligible to work in Canada;
- A member of the Association; and
- A student of Laurentian University.
